AMBASSADOR OVERVIEW

An Ambassador is a representative of the country that they are from. We know that as believers we are Ambassadors of Christ; meaning, that we represent Heaven in all of its glory. You as an Ambassador of Christ, represent Him in and out of the church. You may be the only Bible others may read; therefore, as a result of this university, you will be able to lead, teach and mentor your peers.

As an Ambassador, you are accountable to the adult leaders that are assigned to Ambassador University, as well as all adult leaders in Chrisma.



Purpose: The purpose of Ambassador University is to raise up teens who will lead their peers in a godly lifestyle in and out of the church. You will also learn the fundamentals of ministry and will be able to assist the adult leaders during Chrisma services in any capacity.

Mission: The mission of the Ambassador University is for you to learn and glean from the adult leaders through mentorship, workshops and various activities that will grow you in the Lord, ministry, and everyday life. You must also have a willing heart to serve your peers.

Vision: The vision for the Teen Ambassadors is to fully equip you to become confident to minister to those in and out of the church. By developing your spiritual and natural gifts, you will be able to go out into the world and preach the gospel (Matthew 28:19) with confidence to anyone you encounter.



CODE OF CONDUCT

As an Ambassador for Christ, you must know how to represent the Kingdom and be God's messenger in and out of church. Ambassadors have...

Gracious Speech (Respect One Another)

1. The Ambassadors must be knowledgeable in God's Word so that they speak His Word only; not letting personal opinions get in the way, but always ready to give an answer (I Peter 3:15)
2. Their speech must always model that of Jesus (John 14:10); Using diplomatic language is also important, being able to identify where an individual is in their walk and try to establish some similarities in order to effectively minister to them (Acts 23:6-8)

Common Ground (Be the Light of the World)

1. Ambassadors must be able to establish common ground with those inside and outside the church making sure not to compromise core values when attempting to reach the lost.
2. They should be able to build a bridge of common understanding and similarities as to establish comfortability. (Acts 17:23, 28)
3. They skillfully demonstrate how their country and another country share similar interests.



How Does This Relate to you as an Ambassador?

- Ambassadors are representatives of Jesus Christ and Chrisma, and should act as such
- Ambassadors must be respectful to all leaders and one another in and out of class
- Ambassadors must show themselves friendly, and be active participants in class through answering questions asked, and participating in group activities
- Ambassadors must interact with their accountability partners between classes, and talk to their assigned Ambassador Counselor when assigned to in the syllabus, or feel the need to
- When assigned to sections for serving in Chrisma services, Ambassadors must be actively engaged in duties to help ensure a smooth service
- Ambassadors must be ready to be called on at all times



AMBASSADOR TIPS

- **Be Knowledgeable** – Gain knowledge of the Word by reading and studying your Bible and prayer
- **Listen** – Actively listen to what an individual is saying so that you can hear from God on how to minister to them
- **Be courteous, show hospitality, and be gracious** – always present a calm, assuring and friendly demeanor
- **Always demonstrate respect** – always respect others' opinions, but stand firm in what you know is right according to the Word
